The Messenger of Athens (Hermes Diaktoros #1) Pb 274pp \$23.95

A beguiling and atmospheric detective series set in the Greek islands and featuring the inimitable 'Fat Man', aka Hermes Diaktoros. Each novel is set on a different Greek island and each is based on one of the seven deadly sins. The author creates a wonderful feeling of place in this truly remarkable series. The Fat Man himself is an enigmatic character who never really says who he is other than he is from a higher authority and has come from Athens (or maybe further north)...




Could he be from Olympus? He certainly knows a lot about people before he even gets to the island. No one gets arrested, but everyone pays for their evil deeds and he helps out some of the unfortunate ones... Enigmatic indeed!

The Messenger from Athens is set on the island of Thiminos, where the battered body of a young woman is discovered at the foot of a cliff. The local police dismiss the death as suicide, but a stranger arrives uninvited and announces his intention to look into the crime that he believes has been committed. The stranger's methods of investigation are unorthodox and his message to the islanders is plain: tell the truth or face the consequences! The stranger is of course Hermes Diaktoros. The sin at the heart of this novel is lust.

The Taint of Midas (Hermes Diaktoros #2) Tp 271pp \$32.95 (Due February 2009)

The second in this wonderful series is set on the island of Arcadia. For over half a century, the beautiful Temple of Apollo has been in the care of the old beekeeper Gabrilis. But when the value of the land soars, he is forced to sign away his interests. Hours later, Gabrilis meets a violent and lonely death. When Hermes Diaktoros finds his friend's battered body by a dusty roadside, he soon becomes the prime suspect. But with rapacious developers threatening Arcadia's most



ancient sites, there are many who stand to gain from the death of Gabrilis. Our investigator resolves to avenge his old friend and find the true culprit, but his methods are, as ever, unorthodox. This second novel in the series centres on the sin of greed and I thought it was even better than the first. The Fat Man is an engaging character, but one you would never want to cross. The third instalment in the series is not due until late 2009 and I can hardly wait!
