Although published in 2006, this won the CWA Duncan Lawrie Dagger for Best Crime Novel and subsequently got rave reviews on the Tuesday Book Club in the UK, giving it a new lease of life. Kerry Greenwood came in a creditable second with Trick or Treat, while Ian Rankin took out third spot with Exit Music.
