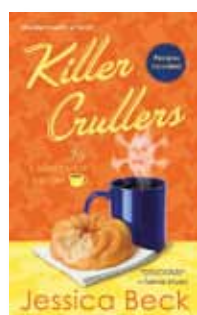
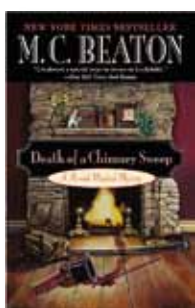
Jeffrey Allen Stay at Home Dead
