





Has the Ripper returned, or is a new killer at large? Walter Day, the squad's newest recruit, is assigned the case and finds a strange ally in the Yard's first forensic pathologist, Dr Bernard Kingsley, who is convinced that strange new techniques such as fingerprinting are the key to finding the person responsible. With Kingsley's help, will Day find the murderer before it's too late? Or are the police once again helpless to stop a serial killer whose brutality knows no limits?



Frederic Stahl, born of Viennese intelligentsia, ran away to sea at the age of 17. Arriving in America, his matinee idol looks and Old World charm took him to Hollywood, and a life of movies and women. But by autumn 1939, the unease in Europe has spread even to Stahl's glamorous enclave. War has been declared, and though bullets and bombs are yet to fly, his decision to shoot a film in Paris seems ill-advised. The Parisians know this is their last spring, and a time to be passionate. Soon after his arrival, Stahl is drawn into a clandestine world of foreign correspondents, exiled Spanish republicans and of course spies of every sort. For as a celebrity from neutral America - who can travel across the continent freely - Stahl could be very useful indeed... Returning to the Brasserie Heiniger and some of the colourful cast from **The World at Night**, this is a headily atmospheric portrait of a continent in the grip of the Phoney War.



Caspian Quinn is a scientist working for the Climatic Impacts Group in a peaceful New Zealand town. It would be an ideal existence, except that the body of his departmental team leader has just washed up on the local beach. In addition, funding and support are about to be withdrawn from the research projects he and his colleagues are working on because they aren't commercial enough, and his French wife is starting to go stir-crazy living in the country. Not to mention the fishing isn't always perfect! His best friend and local policeman, Theo, is being transferred to the CIB, and then another employee of the research station is murdered. Evidence points towards one of Caspian's co-workers, but both he and Theo have their doubts, particularly when Caspian uncovers some very dodgy scientific dealings indeed! A well-paced, colourful and entertaining novel written by a local academic who has personal insights into the parlous state of independent research.
